



## Kathleen Ann Volz

February 25, 1929 - August 28, 2012

Kathleen Ann Volz of Chestertown, MD, died on Tuesday, August 28, 2012, at her home. She was 83.

Born on February 25, 1929, in Vineland, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Edward Wallace and Margaret VanHook Mortimer. Mrs. Volz was a graduate of Trinity College in Washington, DC. where she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry. She worked as a chemist with the National Institute of Health from 1951 to 1961, where her research on smoking damage and cancer cells was published. She later earned a Masters Degree in Psychology from University of Maryland and earned her teaching certificate from the International Montessori Institute.

Mrs. Volz taught Montessori for several years in Washington, DC. She taught children and adults with special needs in both Delaware and Chestertown. Mrs. Volz moved to Fairlee in 1975. In 1980, she opened the Shire Montessori School in Fairlee, which she operated until her retirement in the 90's. Mrs. Volz also worked part-time at H & R Block in Chestertown for over a decade.

She volunteered her time, driving patients to cancer treatments and was an active member of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church in Chestertown, where she taught Sunday School and sang in the choir. She enjoyed gardening, sewing ,and being with her family.

Mrs. Volz is survived by her six children, Christian Volz of Oakland, CA, John O'Neil Volz of Towson, MD, Margaret Lenore Volz of Chestertown, MD, Regina Volz of Easton, MD, Stephen Michael Volz, of Bethesda, MD, and Katherine Volz of Silver Spring, MD; eleven grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

A mass of Christian Burial will be held on Thursday, September 6, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Chestertown, MD, where everyone is invited to dress as she would to honor her vibrant style.

Interment will be held at a later date in New St. Paul's Cemetery in Delaware City, DE.
