Kathleen Alverta Patchett of Easton died at her home on January 19, 2001. She was 79.

Born in Crapo, MD on July 10, 1921, she was the daughter of the late Ralph and Mildred Foxwell Kirwan. She graduated from Cambridge High School in 1939. In 1940, she married Edward I.
