



Kathryn Mullikin Duehrssen

April 27, 1945 - January 28, 2023

Kathryn Mullikin Duehrssen, age 77, and lifetime resident of Easton, MD, died on January 28, 2023.

Born on April 27, 1945, she graduated from Saints Peter and Paul School in 1963 as Valedictorian of her class, and attended Washington College from 1963 to 1967. Kay began a career as a History teacher in Talbot County after graduating. At Easton High School, Kay did numerous extra-curricular activities that included advising student interns for the Maryland General Assembly, being Advisor of National Honor Society, organizing Mock Elections, gathering voting machines from the Board of Supervisors for Elections, holding an assembly for students to gain greater awareness on abuse of women, and preparing students to perform well on the TV game show for "It's Academic." Kay also held classes to prepare students for an assembly on AIDS, and was excited when the talk show host, Phil Donahue, came to speak with them about their experience. Kay taught passionately for 34 years, retiring in 2001.

In 1986, Kay married Ray Duehrssen, a fellow teacher and a football coach. She was an avid reader, sports enthusiast, and politically involved citizen.

She was preceded in death by her father, Robert Mullikin; mother, Margaret Mullikin; sister, Mary Jo Mullikin; and stepdaughter, Elizabeth Duerhssen.

She is survived by her husband, Ray; sister, Donna Kachura; brother, Robert Mullikin and his wife Robin; many cousins, nieces, nephews; and great nieces and nephews. A service will be held at Saints Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church at 1210 S. Washington St. in Easton on February 4, at 11 a.m. Interment will follow at Spring Hill Cemetery, followed by a celebration of her life in the Family Life Center at Saints Peter and Paul's.

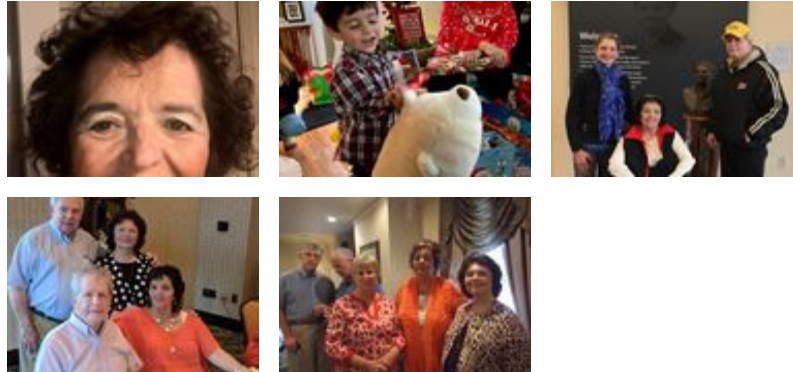
