



Kathryn Schauber Gannon

January 3, 1931 - April 7, 2021

Kathryn Schauber Gannon passed peacefully on April 7, 2021; she was 90 years old. Born January 3, 1931 in Chestertown MD, as the youngest daughter of Bradford Schauber and Frances Myers. She was part of the 1947 graduating class of Chestertown High School. Kathryn then became involved in the family dairy business driving the milk trucks and delivering milk to doorsteps. In 1953 she met Holton Joseph Gannon and the couple was married May 1, 1954. The couple lived on the Gannon family farm in Cordova, then on Murphy Road, Centreville until 1964 at which time they purchased their own farm on Roe-Ingleside Road, Centreville. They farmed this property and in 1979 purchased a farm outside of Church Hill. Holton and Kathryn built their home on the Church Hill farm and resided there until Holton's death in 2017. Kathryn was a bus driver for QACHS from 1964 until 1996 when she became a substitute driver.

Kathryn was preceded in death by her husband, Holton J Gannon, Sr. as well as her siblings, Ann Muriel Jacquette, Frances Eleanor Connolly, William Brandford Schauber, Elizabeth J Glenn and her eldest grandchild Brian Denis.

Kathryn is survived by her six children and spouses: Joe & Sue Gannon, Loretta Gannon, Bradford & Ellen Gannon, Lawrence & Betty Jane Gannon, Monica & Kip Matthews, Wanda & Shane Hampton. Her 17 grandchildren with their spouses and 18 great grandchildren including: Matt & Becky Gannon

“ Mom was often in the background but she was always driving forward. Growing up she was the baby and being raised by her father and grandmother with 4 siblings and a couple young aunts and uncles it was hard to be seen. She helped out on the farm with the dairy by driving and delivering milk on the truck but being a bit too short to reach the high stacked crates of milk, Mom left the dairy business after high school to work at Swietzer’s Hosier Mill in Chestertown. After meeting Dad, with his large personality, Mom remained in the background but it was known that she was the force that kept things moving forward. During the years that dad farmed, mom was driving the trucks and occasionally a tractor and taking care of the record keeping. And even though the school bus contract was in Dad’s name, he only drove it for a short time then once the littlest kids were old enough to go with her each day, Mom took over driving the bus. She drove the school bus for a total of 43 years and was very proud to say she had driven for three generations of children. If Mom was ever late, the bus must have broken down because you could set your watch by her. Dad brought home the first race horse and soon Mom was right there making decisions, keeping the books, naming the foals, attending the races and yes, driving the horse trailer. Mom also designed, supervised and transported materials for the construction of both the home on the Roe-Ingleside farm (the barn shaped house) and the home on Gannon’s Merry Acres. Mom and Dad enjoyed going to Florida in the winter during their later years and of course Mom was the one that did all the driving. Even in the last six months of mom’s life when I would take her out for a drive she would still point the directions to where we were going and put her hands on the dashboard and smile when she saw a yellow light. Mom was always in the driver’s seat of her life and after all these miles, she has reached her destination. Mom, know I love you.
