



Kathryn Lettau

April 9, 1926 - November 24, 2011

Myrtle Kathryn Lettau of Baltimore, MD, formerly of Chestertown and Sudlersville, MD, died Thursday, November 24, 2011, at Esther's Place in Pinewood, Baltimore. She was 85.

Mrs. Lettau was born April 9, 1926 in Erwin, TN, and attended school there. During WWII, Kathryn worked in Oakridge, TN, to help with the war efforts. She physically worked on one of the atomic bombs that were used during the war. As the war moved to an end, she would marry Albert Faye Tittle.

Together they owned and operated a local diner as Albert was employed as the Sheriff of Unicoi County in TN. Albert preceded her in death in the early 1950's and Kathryn moved to Baltimore, MD, to be with her family. She met Robert David Lettau, and they married in 1956. The two resided in Pasedena, MD, where Kathryn worked for Westinghouse in electronic assembly until her husband's retirement in 1968. They then moved to Cecil County to Earlville, MD, for a short time, and then to Remington Farms in Kent County, MD, where Mr. Lettau had worked for 14 years. They would later move to Sudlersville, MD. She enjoyed collecting dolls, finding deals at auctions and flea markets pretty much anywhere and also enjoyed reading.

She is survived by two sons, Albert F. Tittle, Jr., and wife Kathleen of CO, and Robert D. Lettau, Jr. of Sudlersville, MD; one daughter, Janise Kaye Whelan

and husband Michael of Baltimore, MD; four grandchildren, Albert Baron Tittle, Kathryn Lauren Tittle, Mary Ariel Tittle, and Hannah Kaye Alexis Tittle, and one great granddaughter; Violet Bergstedt.

Services will be held on Sunday, November 27, 2011, at 2 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. 6179 Rock Hall Road in Rock Hall, MD, where relatives and friends may call from 12 - 2 p.m.

Burial will be held in St. Paul's Cemetery in Chestertown, MD, following the service.
