



Kathryn M. Vernon

After a long and difficult illness during which she made friends to the very end with her sparkling eyes and beautiful smile, Kathryn M. Vernon of Easton, MD died on St. Patrick's Day, March 17, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 79.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on March 1, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Peter and Mary A. Conlon Malet. After graduating from Bishop McDonald High School in 1945, she worked for the Standard Oil Company in Manhattan until 1951, during which time she also attended Pace Business College. In 1956 she moved to Falls Church, VA where she worked as a real estate agent and then as a secretary for Northern Virginia Community College from 1971 until 1983.

A resident of Easton since 1983, she was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church and the Sts. Anne and Joachim Society. She was also a member of AARP Chapter #1601, the Ladies of the Elks #1622 and the Isaak Walton League. She had been a volunteer with the Talbot Hospice Foundation and was a volunteer with the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary since 1984.

In 1950 she married Martin J. Connell, a Central Intelligence Agency employee, who died in 1971 in Falls Church, VA.

Mrs. Vernon is survived by her devoted husband, Ernest C. Vernon, whom she married in Falls Church, VA in September 1980; two daughters, Maura A. Connell and Kathleen Connell-Dawn, each of Alexandria, VA; three step-sons, David Vernon of Fairfax, VA, John Vernon of Salisbury, MD, and Christopher Theibault of Frostburg, MD; and four grandchildren, Meghan, Matthew, Charles and Christopher. She was predeceased by a sister, Josephine Schnaars and a brother, Frank Malet.

A Memorial Mass for Mrs. Vernon will be celebrated at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Cordova, MD on Friday, March 31, 2006 at 11:00 AM.

Interment will follow at St. Joseph's Catholic Church Cemetery.
