Kay Roser, a native of Kent Island, passed away Sunday, October 8, 2017, peacefully at home.

Kay was a 1957 Stevensville High School graduate. Her parents were Earl W. Seward and Florence Willis Seward of Grasonville, MD. "Seward's Folly" were her brothers Willis Seward and Terry Seward, Sr.

Kay was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, friend and aunt. She is survived by her three daughters, Veronica "Ronnie" McCullough Banner Elk, NC; Michelle (Micki) Roser of Annapolis, MD, and Danita (Dani) Woodhurst (Darryl) of Fort Worth, TX; and grandchildren, Britnie Johnson (Tim); Melissa Stoops; Jordan Woodhurst; Erin Woodhurst and Shannon Woodhurst.

Kay loved her family and friends, and loved to travel. She was an avid nature lover and spent many early mornings driving to photograph the Eastern Shore scenes. Kay's specialty as a professional artist and member of KIFA were oil paints in her earlier days, and she began painting water colors later in life. She took lessons in Washington, DC under Guy Fairlamb. Her work has been displayed in Stevensville.

Kay was married to Kurt F. Roser and raised their three children on Kent Island, later moving to Queenstown to a farm where they enjoyed entertaining,

boating, travel, and life on the shore. She was a brilliant woman who was MD State Spelling Bee in High School. She received a scholarship to college but Kay wanted to stay on Kent Island, get married and have a family. Kay worked with Kurt, her beloved husband of 40 years, at Fred Roser & Sons, their car dealership for 20 years. She managed the finances and helped to run the company as VP. She and Kurt made many friends in the car business and traveled the world with them.

Kay loved her children and grandchildren more than anything and was a mentor, advisor and best friend to them all. She loved to tell stories of adventures growing up on the Eastern Shore with her cousins, aunts and uncles. Kay had 32 aunts and uncles. She loved to take the kids camping to Canada and Maine during the summers. She was an amazing cook whose fried chicken and crab cakes were a favorite. She made her home a house of love and fun. Children from the neighborhood loved to hang out with her and spent many summer days swimming at the pool.

She will be missed by her three daughters most and everyone that loved her.

A visitation will be held on Friday, October 13, 2017, from 6-8 pm at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD.
