Kem McHenry Legg of Chester, Maryland died on December 8, 2006 at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. She was 46.

Born in Chestertown, Maryland on October 12, 1960, she was the daughter of Calvin D. McHenry of Chesapeake City and Joan Elizabeth Sapp Harding of Chestertown, MD.
