Kenneth H. Borman of Chestertown, Maryland died on May 10, 2005 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 86.

Born in Camden, New Jersey on October 15, 1918, he was the son of the late, Ernest and Clara Ballman Borman. He graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in New Jersey and served in the U.S. Army during WWII in the European Theatre. He was honorably discharged in 1945.
