



Kenneth P. Horney

November 19, 1938 - November 29, 2012

Kenneth P. Horney, age 74, of Grasonville, MD died Thursday, November 29th in Chattanooga, TN.

Born November 19, 1938 in Takoma Park, MD, he was raised and lived in the Eastern Shore area for most of his life. Mr. Horney attended the Seventh day Adventist school in Grasonville, MD until the 8th grade. He later attended high school at Shenandoah Valley Academy. Mr. Horney eventually worked with his father, Kenneth William Horney, a plumber by trade who owned his own business named W. Kenneth Horney and Sons Plumbing. He eventually took over the family business when his father died. He met Carmen L. Roman, known as "Lucy" by most, who he married in 1964 in Takoma Park, which led to three beautiful children through the years. Mr. Horney pursued other ventures, such as selling homes for Cardinal Modular Home Inc., and volunteering with Meals on Wheels and the local Adventist church in Grasonville. In the 1980's, he and his wife, Lucy, opened Mink Hill Assisted Living Home, which they ran and operated until they fully retired in 2011. From there they left for the beautiful island of Puerto Rico that same year.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Carmen L. "Lucy" Horney; his two younger brothers John E. Campbell and Brian Horney; his and Lucy's two daughters, Theresa Lou Horney Bechler and family of Georgia, Kay Michelle Horney Dordevic and family of California; their son, Kenneth Manuel Horney

and family of Pennsylvania; their grandchildren: Heather Nicole Horney, Katie Lynn Horney, Crystal Lynn Vaught, Kenneth Manuel Horney Jr., Ashley Victoria Dordevic, Lauren Taylor Dordevic, and John Michael Bechler; their great-grandchildren: Malik Tyraee Roy, Jaihien Sentell Roy, Omari Nadel Roy, and Aireyana Lynn'nea Wilson. They also have many other family members in New Jersey, Tennessee and Puerto Rico.

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 pm on Sunday, December 2 at the Grasonville Seventh-day Adventist Church, where friends may call beginning at 1:00 pm. Burial will follow at Stevensville Cemetery.
