Kenneth Allen Johnson of Centreville, MD died at the University of MD Shore Medical Center at Chestertown on May 15, 2017. He was 72.

Born in Baltimore, MD on June 5, 1944, he was the son of the late Harry Louderman Johnson and Marion Francis Bassler Johnson. He married his high school sweetheart, and "Booti" was his life. Mr. Johnson served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged. He worked for Delta Airlines, and retired after 30 years of dedicated service.
