



Kenneth Joseph Landgraf

June 19, 1953 - December 5, 2015

Joe Landgraf passed away on the evening of December 5, 2015, at Easton Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD, after a yearlong fight with lung cancer. He was 62 years old.

Kenneth Joseph “Joe” Landgraf, Jr., was born in Salisbury, MD, on June 19, 1953. He was the son of the late Kenneth “Ken” Joseph Landgraf, Sr. and Doris Byrd Landgraf. Early on, Joe and his family moved to Easton, which he would call home for the rest of his life. Joe attended St. Peter and Paul School, where he was an active member in sports, arts, as well as a leader within the student body. He then attended Salisbury State University before beginning his career in food service. Joe worked at and managed a number of foodservice establishments across the Eastern Shore. He was a managing partner at Chambers Restaurant in Easton prior to taking a position with RPA Inc. in May of 1989, where he worked for 22 years. Fulfilling a lifelong dream of owning his own restaurant, in September of 2011 Joe became the owner of Joe’s Bagel Café.

Throughout his life on the Eastern Shore, Joe has continually been an active participant in the community and an avid supporter of veteran’s organizations. As a proud 40+ year member of Elks Lodge 1622, Joe served as Exalted Ruler for three different terms, and consistently pushed for greater community involvement. Among many other efforts, he was a longtime advocate and

volunteer for Operation Christmas; providing meals, groceries, clothing, and toys to less fortunate families during the holiday season.

In 1981, Joe met Robin Hall, the daughter of Bob and Shirley Hall of St. Michaels. The two married on September 22, 1984. at Christ Episcopal Church in St. Michaels, MD. They have two children, a son Kenneth Joseph "K.J." Landgraf, III, and a daughter Christina Nicole Landgraf. K.J. is currently a Captain in the United States Air Force, stationed with his wife, Captain Jessica Landgraf, and their two daughters, Taryn Lianne and Alison Rae, in Dayton, OH. Joe's daughter, Christina, is in her fourth year as a kindergarten teacher at Sudlersville Elementary School and resides in Cordova, MD.

In addition to his wife, son, and daughter, Joe is survived by his two sisters, Karen Landgraf Brooks of La Quinta, CA, and Angela Price of Columbia, SC; an aunt, Doris Landgraf of Tonawanda, NY; Robin's four sisters and their husbands; as well as a multitude of cousins, nieces and nephews.

There will be a celebration of Joe's life on Saturday, December 12, 2015, at 1 p.m., at Easton Elk's Lodge 1622, 502 Dutchman's Lane.

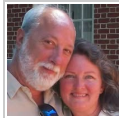

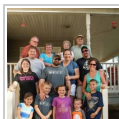
