



## Kenneth "Sonny" "Babo" Mullikin

November 22, 1936 - February 5, 2014

Kenneth "Sonny" "Babo" E. Mullikin passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, February 5, 2014. He was 77.

Kenneth E. Mullikin was born in Easton, MD, on November 22, 1936, the son of the late Kenneth C. and Madeline Sard Mullikin. He attended Easton High School until enlisting in the U.S. Army on October 29, 1956. After serving in Germany for two years, he was honorably discharged in 1958. Upon returning home, he enlisted in the Artillery Tanks Division of the National Guard until 1960. In addition to joining the National Guard, he became a machine operator for Gray Block Ribbon Factory in Easton.

On May 7, 1960, he married Anne Eileen Embry, and they resided in Easton. After 34 years of marriage, his wife, Anne, died on February 6, 1992. The following year he moved to Pasadena, MD, to be with his daughter and son-in-law.

Mr. Mullikin is survived by two children, Kenneth C. Mullikin of Tampa, FL and Teresa A. Scally of Pasadena, MD; four grandchildren, Richard Richmond, Brandon Richmond, Kenneth D. Mullikin and Ellie Mullikin; and a great-grandson, Xavier Maxwell Richmond. In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by a brother, Donald Mullikin.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, February 10, 2014, at 10 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., in Easton, where friends may call on Sunday February 9, 2014, from 7-9 p.m. Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton.
