Kenneth D. Wantling of Chestertown, MD died on November 3, 2006 at his home. He was 68.

Born in Columbus, Ohio he was the son of the late Dr. G.K. Dale Wantling and Leola M. Ross. He was the husband of the late Virginia "Ginger" C. Moore. Mr. Wantling graduated from high school in Beirut, Lebanon in 1956, received a BS and MS degree from the University of Tennessee in 1959 and 1965 he earned an EdS in Administration in Higher Education from the George Washington University in 1972.

Mr. Wantling served in the US Navy Reserve as a research statistician, Assistant Principal of Brainerd Senior High School Chattanooga, Tenn., Head of the Math Dept. and Director of Admissions and Records Chattanooga State Technical Institute, part owner of Cumberland Machine Co. all in the 1960's, Professor of Mathematics Assistant Academic Dean, and Director of Educational Resources, Montgomery College, Rockville, Md. in the 70's and 80's. He was also Visiting Assistant Professor of Mathematics at Washington College, Chestertown, Md. from 1986 to 1997.

Mr. Wantling was active in numerous professional organizations including being a founding member of The American Association of Community and Jr. Colleges. He serves as a governor's appointment to the Advisory Board of Holly Center in Salisbury, MD and had served on the Patient Advisory Board of Blue Cross and Blue Shield. He is also a member of VOR.

Mr. Wantling is survived by two daughters: Cynthia L. Wantling of Salisbury,

MD, and Nicole D. Wantling Allison of Longmont, Colorado, a son: William D. Wantling of Frederick, MD and a brother Brian D. Wantling, he is also survived by three grandchildren: Dakota, Jasper, and Liam.

A memorial service will be held on Wednesday, December 6, 2006 at 1:00 P.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home 130 Speer Road Chestertown, MD. Interment will be held privately.
