Kenneth E. Bryan, of Royal Oak, died at his home on Tuesday, June 1, 2004. He was 43.

Born in Easton, November 8, 1960, he was the son of the late James Marion Bryan and Peggy Cummings Bryan Granger. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1978, he attended the University of Maryland where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Ornamental Horticulture in 1982. He then worked in the family business, Bryan Brothers Landscaping Service until 1992 when he formed his own landscaping and nursery company, Hawksworth Farm Landscaping, in which he remained active until his death.

A resident of Talbot County for most of his life, he was a member of the Mid-Atlantic Nurseryman's Association, Granite Lodge #177, A.F. & A. M, and Phi Delta Theta. An avid hunter, fisherman and decoy collector, he was also a member of Ducks Unlimited, Havre de Grace Decoy Museum and the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum.

Mr. Bryan is survived by his wife, the former Laura Jeanne Camper whom he married in June of 1992; a seven year old daughter, Taylor Marie Bryan; two brothers, Allen Bryan, Sr. and his wife, Georgia and Bill Bryan and his wife, Donna; his step-father, Skip Granger; a step-sister, Cheryl Granger Murphy and her husband, Mike; a sister-in-law, Kimberly Jones Bryan; a brother-in-
