Kenneth G. Townsend, 77, of Brooksville, Florida died Wednesday, June 10th at 11:10pm under the loving care of Hernando Hospice at the new Well Care House in Brooksville, FL.

Born May 22, 1932 in Baltimore, MD to the late, Charles S. and Marie Teresa Townsend. He was a native of Baltimore and served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Wounded in battle, he was awarded the Purple Heart. Shortly after returning home, he and his family moved to the Eastern Shore making their home in Stevensville and later in Chester.

He was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester where he was the Charter Grande Knight of the Fr. Joseph McManus Council of the Knights of Columbus.

Mr. Townsend is survived by his wife, Michaela Townsend of Brooksville, FL; two daughters, Virginia Dalton of Brooksville, FL and Kendra Marvel of Ridgely; one step son, Jon Yuhn of Perry Hall, MD; four step-daughters, Stephanie Michaels of Easton, Lisa Peterson of Shrewsbury, MA, Paige Greene of Pacific Palisades, CA, Sara Davidson of Stevensville and one sister, Carolyn Murray of Sarasota, FL. He leaves twelve grandchildren and three great grandchildren. He is predeceased by one daughter, Marta G.Townsend, one step daughter, Laurie E. Williams, two brothers, Charles S.

Townsend, Jr., William B. Townsend and two sisters, Alvalon Walters and Marion Vance.
