Kenneth William Strotman, Jr. died on September 14, 2008 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 76 years old.

Mr. Strotman was born on May 2, 1932 in Pine City, PA, the son of the late Kenneth William Strotman and Anna Kulp. He attended school in Pine City, PA and went to work part-time in the coal mine when he was nine years old. He married Diane Sue Shaner of Knox, PA on August 27, 1955. They moved to Maryland in 1961 and later settled in Grasonville, MD. Mr. Strotman worked as a heavy equipment operator for Driggs Corp. of Silver Spring, MD for over 30 years. He was a member of Bay Country Moose in Queenstown and he operated the crane at Thunder on the Narrows Boat Races.

Mr. Strotman is survived by his loving wife, Diane Sue "Norma" Shaner Strotman of Grasonville; a daughter, Debra Loveland of Easton, MD; two sons, William L. Strotman and Gregory A.
