Kenny Allan Miller of Grasonville, MD died suddenly of a heart attack on April 24, 2010 in Berlin, MD. He was 40 years old.

Born on January 23, 1970 in Springfield, Ohio, he is the son of Kenneth Lee Miller and Janice Ruth Bing. Kenny grew up in West Liberty, Ohio and was a graduate of West Liberty High School Class of 1989. In July of 1991, he joined the Air Force where he continued his education and served as an Information Specialist. He met his wife, Liz, in 1995 in Japan. In 1999, they married after moving to Millersville and in 2005, moved to the Eastern Shore. He was stationed at Fort Meade in 1998, where he worked as an Information Warfare Analyst. After his honorable discharge in 2002, he worked for numerous contract agencies to include ANSER, RTGX, ANSER, Northrop Grumman, and currently with BAE-IT Systems. He completed his Bachelor of Science Degree in Information Technology with Capella University in 2008 and was actively pursuing his Masters degree in Education.

Kenny had a love for the military and enjoyed spending time with his friends and family, fishing with his son, camping trips, running, NASCAR, chocolate, the HEMI, traveling, and everything related to the Ohio State Buckeyes. He completed his first half-marathon on Saturday and ran numerous races over the last year, with his favorite being the Marine Corps 10K.

Kenny will forever be remembered and is survived by his loving wife, Liz Valdez-Miller of Grasonville, MD; daughter, Alyssa Jacobs of Grasonville, MD; son, Kenny B. Miller of Grasonville, MD. Also, his father, Kenneth Lee Miller and wife Betty of Urbana, Ohio; mother, Janice Bower and husband Eric of Circleville, Ohio; brothers: Randy Miller and wife Jenni, Tommy Hudson and wife Wanda; sisters: Lori Miller, Christine Hudson, Teresa Cheadle and husband Chad, Carol Campbell and husband Clarence, Pat Valentine, and Joanie Busch and husband Greg. He also has countless aunts, uncles, nephews, nieces, cousins, and friends. He is preceded in death by his brother, Russell Murray.

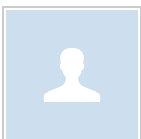
