Kernan M. Kaufman of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, March 2, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines. She was 87.

Born in Boston, Massachusetts, she was raised variously in Dedham, Massachusetts, Duxbury, Massachusetts, the Upper Peninsula of Michigan and Baton Rouge, Louisiana. After completing studies in economics, she graduated from the University of Pennsylvania in 1939, the second graduating class to include women.

On September 12, 1942, she married Frank M. Kaufman II. They raised three children, a son, F. Michael Kaufman III; and two daughters, Nancy Schuyler Kaufman and Lucy Kernan Klakring. The family moved to Oxford, MD in 1964. Mrs. Kaufman worked in a number of careers, and in the 1950's had her own radio show.

Known as Amah to her grandchildren, and Tugboat Kernannie to her husband, Mrs. Kaufman enjoyed reading, crosswords, jigsaw puzzles, putting together parties, and cruising on the Chesapeake Bay on Brigande, the family boat, with friends and family, where there always seemed to be room for one more person. Members of various clubs including Talbot Country Club, Gibson Island and Tred Avon Yacht Clubs, Mrs. Kaufman and her husband enjoyed sharing race committee duties. Using their boat, Brigande, as a race

committee boat, they could tow up to eight Star boats with a resounding arrival.

In addition to her children, Mrs. Kaufman is survived by four grandchildren, Glenn Radford Klakring, Brian Michael Klakring, John Dunlap and Russell Kaufman-Pace.

Memorial services will be held on Sunday, March 6, 2005 at 2:00 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, MD.
