Kevin Klakring of Centreville, MD, died on Sunday, December 24, 2000, at the Arundel General Hospital in Annapolis. He was 46.

Born April 21, 1954, at the Eglin Air Force Base, FL, he was the son of Harold Emerson and Edna Mae Hibberd Klakring of Annapolis. He graduated from Annapolis High School in 1972, and he began working for Honeywell, which later became known as Windermere Information Technologement Systems of Annapolis, MD. He worked for 28 years as a Quality Assurance Technician.
