Kevin Michael Omerza of Stevensville, MD, died on December 27, 2014, at Johns Hopkins University Hospital. He was 60 years old.

He was born on August 7, 1954, on Long Island, NY, to Edith Turner Omerza Schuppert and the late Dr. Daniel Omerza. He grew up in Smithtown, NY. He attended Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, FL, where he earned a BS in Airport Maintenance Management. He later earned a Master's in Information Systems from Lindenwood University in St. Charles, MO. Kevin worked for McDonnell Douglas and most recently for Northrop Grumman in Annapolis.
