



Kevin Scott Starkey

A loving, caring family man, husband father, son, and friend, Kevin Scott Starkey died suddenly on Monday, July 8, 2002, as a result of injuries in an automobile accident. He was 45.

Born June 27, 1957, in Easton, MD, he was the son of James Scott and Barbara Binebrink Starkey. He was a graduate of Queen Anne's County High School in 1975 and on September 7, 1979, he married the former Susie Blanchfield. They resided in Centreville, and he worked with the Willow Construction Company as a carpenter and with Horizon Design as a shop manager/craftsman. He then worked for 12 years for BAI Aero Systems in Easton, MD, where he had been a craftsman/designer.

He had formerly been an active volunteer of the Goodwill Fire Company in Centreville and had been a Boy Scout and later a Boy Scout Leader and was a coach with the Little League Baseball. He was also a history and Civil War buff and enjoyed painting, pen and ink, as well as carving of wildlife and country scenes.

In addition to his parents and wife, Mr. Starkey is survived by three sons, Richard Starkey and his wife, Nicole, William Starkey and Scott Starkey, all of Centreville.

Funeral Services will be held at the Centreville United Methodist Church, Centreville, MD, on Friday, July 12, 2002 at 11:00 AM.
