



## Kristel V. Mitchell

September 1, 1967 - March 7, 2010

Kristel V. Mitchell died at the Memorial Hospital in Easton on March 7, 2010. She was 42 years old.

Born on September 1, 1967, she was the daughter of Ronald and Joyce McLeod Wolf of Wheeling, WV. She graduated from Wheeling Park High School in 1985, and attended West Liberty State College. She most recently worked as the MRI and Radiology Supervisor at the Memorial Hospital in Easton.
