July 29, 1960 - January 12, 2025

Kristin Kent Jaramillo, a beloved wife, mother, and grandmother, passed away peacefully on January 12, 2025, at Johns Hopkins Hospital. She was 64 years old. Born on July 29, 1960, near Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, she was the cherished daughter of Nanette Peterson and the late James K. Peterson.

On July 16, 1988, Kristin married the love of her life, Peter P. Jaramillo. Together, they shared over 36 years of marriage, building a life filled with love, laughter, and cherished memories. Their journey together began in West Chester, Pennsylvania, where they started their family.
