Kurt Nicolas Marley, 59, of Chester, MD passed away at the Washington Hospital Center on April 9, 2012.

Born on January 5, 1953 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late King Marley and Helen Sprinkle Marley. Kurt grew up in Arnold, MD and graduated from Severna Park High School. He worked for 30 years as a construction estimator, most recently for Aggregate Industries in Greenbelt. In 1990, the Marleys' moved to Chester, MD.

Kurt was an avid bowler, cook, and an outdoor enthusiast who enjoyed fishing, crabbing and archery. He loved spending time with his children.

He is survived by his wife, Marianne Corinne Marley, whom he married on May 6, 1978; his sons, Tristan Nicolas and Travis Nathan Marley and a brother, George Brown of Florida.
