Linda Diane Ford, of Chester, MD, died at her home on Thursday, August 22, 2002. She was 53.

Born in Jackson, MS, on September 21, 1948, she was the daughter of late John L. Mooney, Jr., and Mary Lou Austin Mooney. Mrs. Ford grew up in Shreveport, LA, and graduated from Byrd High School in 1966. She attended college at South Eastern Louisiana State College for a year before marrying Daniel Lee Ford on February 7, 1970. Mr. Ford was in the US Air Force, allowing them to spend much time overseas. She was a homemaker until her husband's retirement in 1989 when she began working for Almost Family Adult Day Care in 1990 at the Pasadena branch. They moved to Bayside in Chester in 1997.

In addition, to her husband and mother, Mrs. Ford is survived by three daughters, Deborah S. Breen of Shreveport, LA, Stephanie D Jackman of Preston, and Rebecca J. Ewing of Preston; a son Daniel L. Ford, II of Ridgely; a brother, Leslie Mooney of Shreveport, LA; and six grandchildren.
