Larry Wayne Searce, Sr. of Rock Hall, MD passed away on August 24, 2021, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Easton, MD. He was 74.

Born on October 6, 1946, in Danville, VA, he was the son of the late James Algie Searce and Rose Marie Anderson Searce.

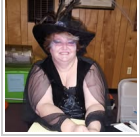
