



## Larry Alan Ward

June 25, 1944 - May 13, 2014

Larry Alan Ward of Easton, MD, formerly of Annapolis, MD, passed away on Tuesday, May 13, 2014, following a very hard-fought battle with cancer. He was 69.

Born on June 25, 1944, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Clarence Ireland Ward and Eunice Rose Whitby Ward.

Larry was a longtime employee of the newspaper industry. He began his career at The Capital newspaper in Annapolis. Following a brief stint at The Washington Star, Larry returned to The Capital where he spent the next 25 years. During that time he met his wife, Sandy. He was well-loved by his co-workers for his work ethic, kindness, and sense of humor. Larry was a political junkie and a lifelong Orioles fan. He loved taking his daily walk, lifting weights, eating Maryland crabs, and relaxing with his feline buddies, Rosie and Lily.

Larry is survived by his wife of 16 years, Sandy Owens Ward of Easton; sisters, Linda Kennedy of Edgewater, MD, and Penelope Bassford of Bridgeville, DE; stepdaughters, Kim Ulmer of Rockville, MD, and Kristi Ulmer of Seattle, WA; nieces, Donna Rinehart and Angel Bassford, of Bridgeville, DE; nephews, Alan Bassford and David Bassford, of Delaware, and Jason Thorne, of Lusby, MD; cousin, Ronnie Ward, and his wife, Nancy Ward, of Edgewater, MD.

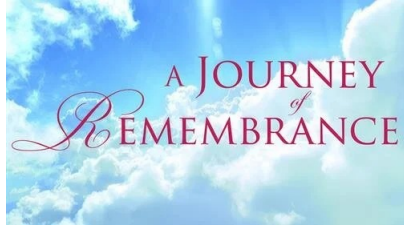
