Larry Lee Yeatman, Jr. of Easton died on Saturday, February 24, 2007. He was 25.

Born July 8, 1981 he was the son of Larry Lee Sr. and Nell Elizabeth Blades Yeatman. After graduating from Easton High School in 1999 he attended 2 years at New England College in Heineker, New Hampshire then at Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina where he received his bachelor's degree in graphic design in 2003. He then worked in Spartansburg pursuing his career in graphic design. Larry then moved back to Easton in fall 2004 where he worked several part-time jobs while pursuing a career to become a professional fire fighter.

Larry was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church and the Easton Volunteer Fire Department, Station 60. He enjoyed his time coaching the youth ice hockey program here in Talbot County, the Fire Department, numerous sports, and spending time with his family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Larry is survived by a sister, Amber Elizabeth Yeatman of Easton; maternal grandfather, Harry Bolden "John" Blades Jr. of Easton; paternal grandmother, Olive Gertrude Yeatman of Bethlehem; very dear and loving girlfriend, Kristin Elaine Frey of West Orange, New Jersey; and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins. He was predeceased by two

grandparents, maternal grandmother, Margaret Elizabeth Shortall Blades who died in 1973, and paternal grandfather, Nelson Franklin Yeatman who died in 2000.
