Laura Marie Hawkins of Federalsburg, MD, formerly of Kent County Maryland, died on April 18, 2003 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. She was 92.

Born in Queenstown, MD on July 13, 1910, she was the daughter of the late Henry Clay and Anna Lucille Greaves Woolford.

She married Charles Nelson Hawkins and they raised their family on their farm on Bakers Lane in Chestertown, MD. She was known for her cooking especially her "hot rolls". She also enjoyed sewing and gardening. Mrs. Hawkins belonged to the homemakers association while residing in Chestertown, MD and the Kent County Farm Bureau.

Mr. Hawkins died in 1995.

Prior to living in Federalsburg for the past year, she spent 8 years with her daughter in Millington, MD.

Mrs. Hawkins is survived by two sons, Charles T. Hawkins of Kenton, DE and William H. Hawkins of Federalsburg, MD; one daughter, Mary E. Downey of Millington, MD; a grandson that she raised, John N. Hawkins of Chestertown, MD; three sisters, Grace Vickers of Cambridge, MD, Esther Dill of Easton, MD and Blanche Usilton of Greensboro, MD; 16 grandchildren, 29 great grandchildren, and 4 great great grandchildren. One daughter, Virginia M. Glisson predeceased her in 1997.
