Laura Dean Puppe of Rock Hall, MD, died Monday, October 24, 2011, at her home surrounded by her family. She was 79.

Laura D. Puppe was born October 10, 1932, in Rock Hall, MD, the daughter of the late Frank Heinefield and Annie Watson Heinefield.
