Laura Maye Soulsman of Ocean City, MD, formerly of St. Michaels, MD, died on Wednesday, February 13, 2019, at her son's home. She was 97.

She was born March 29, 1921, in St. Michaels, MD, the daughter of the late Joseph Howard Spurry and Caroline Virginia Seymour Spurry. She married Albert Fairbank Soulsman on May 30, 1941, and they made their home in St. Michaels. Mrs. Soulsman graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1938. She attended Chesapeake College and received her real estate license. She was a medical secretary for four doctors in St. Michaels. She loved St. Michaels and crabbing.

She was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, a life member of the Miles River Yacht Club, Eastern Star, Talbot County Diving Club, and the St. Michaels Volunteer Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary.

She is survived by her sons, Rev. Ronald H. Soulsman and his wife, Rev. Nancy Wolff Soulsman of Ocean City, and Dudley F. Soulsman and his wife Renee Pike Soulsman of Easton; three grandchildren, Brad Soulsman (Pam), Becky Lynch (Doug), and Amy Renee Soulsman Lewis; six great-grandchildren, Madison, Morgan, Brooke, Adam, Justin and Kaley; and a nephew, Vance Strausburg. She was preceded in death by her husband of 56 years, Albert F. Soulsman, and her sister, Evelyn Strausburg.
