



## Laura S. Harrison

September 30, 1938 - February 28, 2011

Laura S. Harrison of Easton died on February 28, 2011. She was 72 years old.

Born in Wittman on September 30, 1938, she was the daughter of the late James M. and Alice Dulin Sewell. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1956, she continued her studies by completing the Memorial Hospital School of Nursing program in 1959. Mrs. Harrison then earned her BSN from the University of Maryland in 1963. She was an instructor at the Memorial Hospital School of Nursing and then she finished her career as a staff nurse.

Mrs. Harrison was a member of the National Association of Orthopedic Nurses. She was a former member of the Talbot County Board of Education, having been appointed by Governor William Donald Schaefer in 1985. She was reappointed by the Governor in 1990 for an addition five-year term, and served both as President and Vice President during her tenure on the Board. She was also a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, where she served in various capacities. She enjoyed reading, gardening and especially enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren.

She is survived by her husband, Raymond T. Harrison, Jr., whom she married on November 7, 1964; her children: Raymond T. Harrison, III (Susan) of

Easton, James S. Harrison (Annette) of Cordova, and Paul A. Harrison (Sandy) of Easton; her sisters: Marie Swartz of Easton, Etta Miller of Wittman and Emily Ortt of Easton; and her grandchildren: Sam, Martha, Victoria, Allison, Hannah. She was preceded in death by her brother, James "Buddy" Sewell.
