LaVerne Dorothy Emery of Queenstown, MD died at her home on Thursday, December 18, 2008. She was 92.

Born September 26, 1916 in Milwaukee, WI, she was the daughter of the late William and Ella Thomas Platt. She graduated from Bay View High School in 1934 and worked for the Milwaukee Sentinel for 5 years. On April 20, 1940 she married A. Rod Emery. Mr. Emery died in 1973. In 1960 she started working for Nordberg Manufacturing Company of Milwaukee, WI and later retired in 1981.

She was a member of the Ascension Evangelical Lutheran Church of Milwaukee, WI.

Mrs. Emery is survived by a daughter, Carol Lynn McConnell of Queenstown; two sisters, Bernice Fox of Milwaukee, WI and Beverly Campbell of Greenfield, WI and two grandchildren. She was pre-deceased by a son, Ralph C. Emery who died in 2004 and a brother, Ervin W. Platt.
