November 12, 1929 - October 28, 2024

Lavinia Brice Slagle passed away peacefully on October 28, 2024. She was 94 years old.

She was born in Lankford, Kent County, MD on November 12, 1929, the daughter of the late Harry Brice and Amanda (Thomas) Brice. She graduated from Chestertown High School with the class of 1947. After graduating, she worked various jobs around Chestertown before finding her career as a librarian at Washington College. In 1950, she married the love of her life, Robert "Snookie" Slagle.
