



## Lawrence Adams

Lawrence W. Adams, Jr., of Chestertown, MD, died on Tuesday November 13, 2001, at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown. He was 75.

Born on Thursday December 3, 1925, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Lawrence W. Sr. and Mildred Szypula Adams. On June 25, 1955, he married Margaret A. Robinson of Chestertown.

Mr. Adams was a 1943 graduate of Albert Leonard High School in Baltimore, MD, and then attended the University of Maryland. Mr. Adams served in the U.S. Navy during WWII as pilot in the Pacific theatre where he was decorated with three stars. He later served in Korea, with the United Nations, and in the Phillippines Liberation with one star. He served from 1943-1967. Upon his honorable discharge, he worked as a commercial pilot for O.N.A. and Evergreen Airlines for 15 years. He moved from Edgewater Park, NJ, to Chestertown, MD, in 1978.

Mr. Adams was very active with the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown where he was a past Post Commander, County Commander, Post Finance Officer, and District Finance Officer. He was also very active with the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown where he served as Deacon. Mr. Adams was an excellent cook.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Joseph Kelly Adams and Lawrence W. Adams, III, both of Worton, MD; a daughter, Leslie Ann Miller of Chestertown, MD; and four grandsons.

Funeral services will be held at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown on Saturday, November 17, 2001, at 11 a.m.

Relatives and friends may call on Friday, November 16, 2001, between the hours of 6 and 8 p.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road in Chestertown.

Interment will be on Monday, November 19, 2001, at 11 a.m. at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery near Hurlock, MD.
