



Lawrence Edward Ewing Jr.

October 18, 1923 - August 7, 2017

Lawrence Edward Ewing, Jr., a longtime farmer in Talbot County, passed away peacefully in the afternoon at his home on August 7, 2017. He was 93 years old.

Lawrence was born on October 18, 1923, son of the late Lawrence E. Ewing, Sr. and Birdie Draper Ewing from Centreville, MD. He was the second youngest of two brothers and four sisters. He spent his early life farming with his family, going to school in Queen Anne County and dreaming of flying. He met and then married Muriel Alton of Easton on January 19, 1946. After farming a few years in Queen Anne County, they moved to Talbot County in 1949, purchasing their home farm in 1952, beginning a long life of hard work and the eventual purchases of several more farms in Talbot County.

Lawrence and Muriel had two children: Diana Lynne Ewing (Lynne Ewing Carels) who preceded her father in death in 2006 and a son, Lawrence Alton Ewing who joined them in the farming operation in 1974 after returning from college. His lifelong ambition to become a pilot was realized in April of 1972 and he later bought an airplane, his joy.

Lawrence was a long time member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, a member of Easton Elks Lodge # 1622, a charter member of Easton Ruritan, and a Farm Bureau member. \Lawrence was a member of

International Flying Farmers, taking him and Muriel all over the Continental United States, Canada, and even parts of Central America. Their adventures continued with IFF spanning over 4 decades and making many wonderful friends along the way.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Muriel E. Ewing; his son, Lawrence A. Ewing (Margaret); a sister, Virginia Lee Fleming (Tommy); and a sister-in-law, Eloise Ewing. Lawrence and Muriel have six grandchildren; Lauren Lowe (John), Brandon Hesson (Renee), Brian Ewing, Stephen Ewing, Marshall Hesson and Diana Hesson. They were blessed with 10 great grandchildren with one on the way!

The family would especially like to thank the caregivers, friends and family for their comfort and kindness over the last few weeks.

A visitation will be held on Sunday, August 13, 2017, from 3-5 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton. A funeral service will be held on Monday, August 14, 2017 at 11:00 AM. Interment will follow in Springhill Cemetery in Easton.

“ I am so sad to know that Uncle Punchie has passed. Please accept my deepest condolences Aunt Muriel, Larry and families. As a young girl, I remember his laughter and his teasing ways. He was like his father that way (Pop Pop Ewing, Sr.). I remember he would have a new Cadillac just about every year. When my sisters and I (and later brother, Michael) were little we use to watch him milk cows. He was patient and showed us how it was done. He and Aunt Muriel had a little rat terrier they loved and the rat terrier would sit on Uncle Punchie's lap. I always thought Uncle Punchie was huge. He and Uncle Marion (his brother) would walk into our Mom Mom Ewing's kitchen and living room and they seemed like giants to me. They (along with my aunts and uncles) would talk in the smokey living room for hours and it was comforting to listen to them. Uncle Punchie always took time to pay attention to us and he made me feel special. Uncle Punchie was very kind to his Mom (my Mom Mom) and I could feel their close relationship. I also know that he and my Mom loved each other very much. I remember he showed me his airplane and told me before he took flight, he touched every square inch. I was told that during WWII Uncle Punchie went to volunteer as a Navy pilot without Pop Pop Ewing knowing it. When Pop Pop found out, he went to get Uncle Punchie (who was not too happy). He did, too, get his son and said he needed him on the farm. I'll never forget that Uncle Punchie let us bury our beloved dog, Missy, on his farm behind a barn. She died when I was 13 while we were staying in Bozman and it was very traumatic. Uncle Punchie was so nice to us when he was surrounded by the Fleming girls crying from the loss of their dog. I'll never forget that. Goodbye Uncle Punchie. I love you and know I will see you again. Love, your niece, Susan

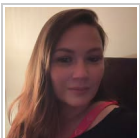
