October 1, 1926 - December 31, 2014

Lawrence Clifton, “Tink” Taylor of Worton, MD, died on Wednesday, December 31, 2014, at his home. He was 88.

Born on October 1, 1926, in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of the late Wendall Holmes Taylor and Susie B. Rollison Green. Mr. Taylor entered the United States Navy in 1943. He served during World War II and the Korean War, until he was honorably discharged in 1963. He later worked for Washington College in the Maintenance Department. After retirement, he worked part-time at Caulks Field Café. Mr. Taylor was a member of the Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion, Post # 228 in Rock Hall. He enjoyed fishing and crabbing. Mr. Taylor also liked to tinker and fix things.

He is survived by two daughters, Lauren E. Ferguson and Alan of Hartly, DE; Lisa D. Pepper of Worton, MD; adopted daughter Cathy Yerkie and her husband Roger of Still Pond, MD; five grandchildren, Jessica L. Roe and husband Mathew of Elkton, MD, James L.
