



## Lawrence T. Wittman

Lawrence T. Wittman Jr. of Easton died on Friday, December 21, 2007, at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 74.

Born in Catasauqua, PA, on January 29, 1933, he was the son of the late Lawrence T. and Helen Rokoski Wittman. Following his graduation from Allentown High School, Allentown, PA, in 1950 he attended Pennsylvania State University. He then served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. On February 19, 1956, he married the former Patricia Shipe of Allentown, PA, and they made their home in Turnersville, NJ, where he was President of Paris Foods Corporation until his retirement in 1986. Following their move to Talbot County, Mr. Wittman entered the real-estate business opening Premier Properties in St. Michaels. He established Wittman Enterprises, a real-estate services company. Later he formed an extensive partnership with Pauline Bateson and began Century Twenty-One Today's Choice Realty with offices in St. Michaels, Easton, and Preston. Together they also formed the Witt-Paul Corporation, a real-estate development firm. Mr. Wittman, although semi-retired, continued to manage Century Twenty-One Corporation in Preston.

Memberships include: Board member of the Mid- Shore Symphony, Board member of the Miles River Yacht Club, Board member of the Easter Seals of Delmarva, President of the Delmarva Broker Counsel, and a long standing member of the Harbortowne Resort & Country Club.

In addition to his wife of 51 years, Mr. Wittman is survived by his sister Lucy A. Dries of Macungie, PA and his six children: Scott Wittman and his wife Dona of Milton, DE, Laurel Wittman of Margate City, NJ, Eric Wittman of Ashton, VA, Gretchen Cheezum and her husband Andy of Centreville, MD, L. Todd Wittman and his wife Peggy of Easton, Kurt Wittman and his wife Shannon also of Easton, and nine grandchildren: Jessica, Evan, Ryan, Drew, Olivia, Emily, Abigail, Kurt Jr., and Lukas.

He was preceded in death by an infant son Lawrence T. Wittman III and his brother James F. Wittman of Allentown, PA.

A memorial service will be held at the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton on Saturday, January 5, 2008, at 1:00 P.M.

Burial will be private.
