Lawrence V. Lutes of Easton, MD died on Friday, November 14, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 90.

Born June 16, 1913 in Washington, D.C., he was the son of the late Fred Lawrence and Mary Louise Forni Lutes. After graduating from Takoma High School in Takoma Park, MD in the early 1930's, he attended the University of Maryland, where in 1937 he received a BA degree in Business Administration. From 1937 to 1940 he attended Southeastern University Law School in Washington, D.C. During World War II, from 1942 to 1945 he was a special agent for the FBI. He then began a career in real estate in Silver Spring, MD. In 1970 he moved to Easton and continued working in real estate until his retirement in 1984. In his spare time he enjoyed gardening, hunting and traveling.

The former Neale Walker, whom he married in 1938, died June 7, 1976.

Mr. Lutes is survived by his second wife, the former Robina Boyd, whom he married February 11, 1978; a son, Fred L. Lutes of Silver Spring, MD; a daughter, Brenda L. Holmes of Easton, MD; four grandchildren and one great-grandchild. He was predeceased by two sisters.
