Lea Rosenberger Chaires of Queen Anne, died on March 2, 2011. She was 74.

Born in Philadelphia, PA on March 10, 1936, she was the daughter of the late, Harry and Clara Fisher Rosenberger. After graduating from Bethesda Chevy Chase High School in Montgomery County, Maryland in 1954, she attended Easton Memorial Hospital School of Nursing, graduating in 1957. In 1959 she married G. Neal Chaires. Mr. Chaires died in April 2000. From 1962 until 1997, she worked at the Memorial Hospital in various departments, with her last position being Infection Control Coordinator.
