Lee L. Dye of Centreville, MD, died on May 28, 2015, at Greenfield Senior Assisted Living in Bel Air, MD.

Mr. Dye was born on February 12, 1928, in Tekamah, NE, to the late Charles T. Dye and Evelyn E. Swanson Dye. He attended Centreville High School in Centreville, DE, and graduated in the Class of 1944. Mr. Dye enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1946 and was honorably discharged in 1948. After his military career, he received a degree from Goldey College in Delaware. In 1949, Mr. Dye began working for Worth Steel in sales. In 1970, he took a position with Ryerson Steel, from which he retired in 1991.

In November of 1949, he married the former Mary Ethel Cook, and they resided in Wilmington, DE. In 2000, the Dyes moved to Centreville, MD.

Mr. Dye was a member of the AARP, Methodist men's group in Centreville, MD, and the Easton Bowling League. He enjoyed golfing and fishing.

Mr. Dye is survived by his children, Thomas L. Dye and Richard W. Dye; grandchildren, Michael D. Dye and Holly L. Dye; a great-grandchild, Liam Todd; and three sisters, Lucille Olinger, Marjorie Stockman, and Donna Ray Frase. His wife, Mary Ethel Dye; a daughter, Debra L. Dye; and a great-grandson, Benjamin R. Dye, preceded him in death.
