



## Lee Faulkner

Lee Faulkner of Centreville, MD died on Thursday, March 4, 2004 at Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. He was 83.

Born November 21, 1920 in Ridgely, MD, he was the son of the late William Nathan and Bessie Lee Wotters Faulkner. He attended school in Denton, MD and began working on his family's farm on Holly Road in Ridgely. Later he worked on Wye Plantation on Wye Island. He married Sarah Viola Seward on October 1, 1949 and in December they moved to the Hermitage Farm in Centreville where Lee dedicated his next 53 years as a farmer to preserving the peaceful nature of the estate.

Lee loved wildlife and the natural beauty of the land. He enjoyed fishing and had a special understanding of animals. Lee was a kind and generous man, and everyone who knew him was genuinely fond of him.

Lee's wife, Viola predeceased him on October 15, 1999.

Mr. Faulkner is survived by his son, Kip Faulkner; two brothers, Emmett Faulkner and Paul Faulkner; three sisters, Hannah McGhee, Kitty Faulkner and Lois McCord. In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by three brothers, Bill, Jim and Sam and two sisters, Mary Ann and Eunice. His "second family" which includes Donna Leager and the Tilghman family also

mourns his loss.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, March 8, 16 11:00 AM at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Centreville, MD where the family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.

Interment will be in Chesterfield Cemetery, Centreville, MD.
