Lee “Buster” Kaufman of Chester, MD died on Tuesday, April 29, 2003 at Corsica Hills Nursing Center, Centreville, MD. He was 80.

Born August 31, 1922 in Centreville, he was the son of the late Fred and Lola Mae Thompson Kaufman. He was raised in Chester, MD and graduated from Stevensville High School in 1939. He enlisted in the U.S. Army during World War II and served in the Pacific Theatre of Operations. Following his release from active duty he worked for the Army Corp of Engineers doing survey work up and down the east coast onboard ships. He was a restaurant manager at Old Cove Inn, Castle Marina Restaurant, both in Chester, MD and the Islander in Stevensville, MD and Martingham in St. Michaels. In addition, he was a school bus contractor for over 25 years.

He was a member of the Christ Episcopal Church, Stevensville, MD; a charter member and help to build and run the Grasonville VFW, Post #7464, Kent Island American Legion, Post #273 and a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club.

Mr. Kaufman is survived by a son, Thompson “Tom” Kaufman & his wife Donna of Chester, MD; a daughter, Peggy Gardner of Grasonville, MD; five sisters, Helen Hicks of Virginia Beach, VA, Betty Ann Fulford of Holden’s Beach, NC, Irene Bryan of Grasonville, MD, Ruth Wyatt of Chester, MD and

Barbara Bostic of Ingleside, MD; two grandchildren, Terie Jean Morris and Randy Morris, both of Chester, MD. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Lola May Kaufman who died in 1958.
