Lee Walls, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Friday, September 13, 2002. She was 73.

Born in Easton, December 28, 1928, she was the daughter of the late George Lee and Della Mulliken Whiteley. After graduating from Easton High School in 1945, she worked as a model at Saks Fifth Avenue in New York City. Following her marriage in 1947 to Charles B. Walls, they made their home in Easton where Mr. Walls died July 18, 1991.

A resident of Easton for the majority of her life, she was a member of the First Baptist Church of Easton where she had served in various capacities including the church nursery, the Vacation Bible School, missions work and, most recently for the last five years, the Church Clerk.

Mrs. Walls is survived by two children, C. Craig Walls of Easton and V. Colleen Tjalma of Rougemont, North Carolina; a sister, Dee Ayres of Easton; three grandchildren, Jake Tjalma, C. J. Walls and Kelsey Tjalma.
