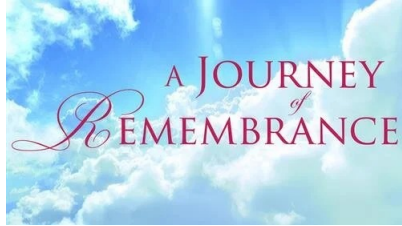
Interment will follow at Stevensville Cemetery.

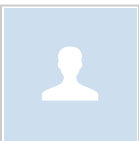
