Lee Carskaddon Cook of Trappe, MD died on Thursday, January 31, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 80.

Born June 24, 1927 in Lansdowne, PA, he was the son of the late Langdon Austin and Marie Carskaddon Cook. After graduating from Lansdowne High School he served in the U.S. Navy. After his release from the Navy he attended and graduated from Washington College in Chestertown, MD. During the Korean War, from 1951 to 1953, he served in the U.S. Marines, earning the Purple Heart, Bronze Star and the Silver Star. He was employed as a District Sales Manager for the Phoenix Steel Corporation for over thirty-five years.
