



## Lee Elder Hawks

Lee Elder Hawks, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Thursday, January 3, 2002. He was 78.

Born in Pendergrass, GA, April 4, 1923, he was the son of the late Floyd and Belle Long Hawks. As a child he moved with his parents to Lowell, N.C. where he graduated from high school. He then served in the U. S. Navy in the European Theatre of Operations during World War II. Following his release from active duty in 1945, he worked in home construction until 1960 when he entered Civil Service with the U. S. Government. At the time of his retirement in 1983, he was the Facility Manager at the D. C. Children's Center in Laurel, MD. Following retirement, he moved to Easton from Laurel, MD where he was a member and Past Master of the Laurel Masonic Lodge #121. Locally, he was a member of the Oxford United Methodist Church, the Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital, the Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and the Talbot County Chapter #1601, AARP of which he was a Past-President.

Mr. Hawks is survived by his wife, the former Gloria A. Perry whom he married in Annapolis on September 1, 1973; a son, Jimmy L. Hawks of Saratoga Springs, N.Y.; a brother, Floyd Hawks, Jr. of Lowell, N.C.; two granddaughters, Wendy Hawks and Lara Motheral and two devoted nephews, Robert LaDue and Ronald LaDue.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, January 8th, at 7 P.M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, at a later date.
