Lee Gordon Funk of Chestertown, Maryland died on November 25, 2004 at his home. He was 81.

Born on June 4, 1923, he was the son of the the late Henry and Ruth Simpson Funk of Baltimore, Maryland. He attended Baltimore City College and served in the United States Army form 1948 to 1949 and from 1950 to 1951, when he was honorably discharged. In 1953 he remarried the former, Betty May Lippy and they resided in Baltimore where he worked with Bethlehem Steel in the shipyard division. Upon completion of his apprentice and journeyman programs, he worked as a brick layer with Bethlehem Steel until retiring in 1985. He and his wife moved to Chestertown in 2003.
