



## Lelia Mae Hunter

April 9, 1920 - November 21, 2011

Lelia Mae Hunter of Grasonville, MD, died on November 21, 2011. She was 91.

Born at the Hermitage in Queenstown, MD, on April 9, 1920, she was the daughter of the late Alfred Kersey and Julia Young Sewell. She attended school in Grasonville, MD, and, in January 1934, she married James Edison Hunter of Queenstown, MD. He predeceased her on March 6, 1988. Mrs. Hunter helped her husband develop the Hunter's Seafood Market in Grasonville, MD, which is still run by her family.

Mrs. Hunter was very artistic and loved to spend time with her family.

She is survived by her children, James "Dickie" Hunter, Jr., and Jerry Hunter, both of Queenstown, Timothy Allen Hunter, Sr., of Wye Mills, Sylvia Taylor of Chester, and Pamela Hope Harrison of Chestertown; 17 grandchildren; 35 great-grandchildren; and eight great-great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her sisters, Martha Starkey, Mary Sparks, Ethel Bennett, Violet Butler, and Betty Sewell; and her brothers, John and Cooley Sewell.
